



HERRINGBONE ENGINEERED HARDWOOD FLOORING













Herringbone is most popularly used flooring pattern around the world. This simple yet stylish pattern come in several variations ranging from single, double and diagonal blocks or strips. They add grace and finesse to the uber-trendy home décor styling. Herringbone wood flooring was introduced by the Francis who had hired an Italian craftsman to refurbish his Palace of Fontainebleau in the year 1539 (located 55 kilometres (34 miles) southeast of the center of Paris). The popularity of this patterned flooring soured high in the 17th and 18 century when various palaces, castles, and noblemen's houses across Western Europe became home to this elegant flooring design.
